



GENERAL ELECTIONS GUIDELINES:

- 1) Elections will be held on April 10th during the general meeting in Alderson Auditorium at 7:00
- 2) Candidates must turn in their application and statement to Jasmine Shaw at jmshaw21@gmail.com no later than April 9th, 2007 12:00 pm
- 3) Candidates may indicate up to 2 positions of interest, but may only stand during elections for 1 of the positions
 - a. Candidates will be considered for the second position if there were no standing candidates for that position.
 - b. All candidates listing a "non-candidate" position will be then announced for their second option at which time members can vote for those positions
- 4) If only 1 candidate runs for a particular position, they will win that position by default, but will still submit their statement and stand during elections
- 5) If there are no candidates for a particular position, members may be considered for those positions at that time
 - a. Any positions left unfilled following elections may remain unfilled and left to the discretion of the incoming executive board following turnover of leadership on 5/1/07
- 6) Ballots will be counted in the presence of at least 3 current executive board members and all members and candidates will be notified of the results by the end of the 4/10/07 meeting
- 7) The matter of candidates who will study abroad during a portion of their leadership is still being considered. Members will be provided with advance notice of the decision so that they can move forward accordingly
