Membership (Four classes)*

Regular:

- Be an undergraduate major in the biological sciences
- Be enrolled in the first semester of the 2nd year of courses
- Have taken 3 Biology courses (at least one beyond introductory level), and have received an average grade of at least a B

Associate:

- Have a strong interest in the life sciences, but ineligible as a regular member

Graduate:

- Be a graduate student currently enrolled in the biological sciences

Chapter Honorary Members:

- Elected by members in recognition of outstanding accomplishments or service

There is a one-time fee for Regular for National and Local Membership, \$35, which must be paid upon application. Associate members have a one-time fee of \$25 for Membership.
